

2018 Kansas Statutes

46-1116. Crime of failure to make records available for post audit defined and classified. [See Revisor's Note] Failure to make records available for post audit is the intentional failure to make any books, accounts, contracts or records, files, documents and correspondence, confidential or otherwise, related to any of the foregoing available to the post auditor or to a firm performing a financial-compliance audit or any officer or employee of the division of post audit or of such firm upon request of the post auditor or such firm or any such officer or employee for the purpose of post audit as directed by the legislative post audit committee under authority of this act.

Failure to make records available for post audit is a class A misdemeanor.
