
The subject bill contemplates strengthening the counting of provisional ballots. Since 2010 I have been intimidated by Kansas for voting, and have cast uncounted Provisional Ballots since 2014 in Johnson and Wyandotte Counties. I filed suit against the Johnson County DA, Case No. 2015-CV-6836 to release voting records, when weeks later, the DA retaliated by arresting me for voting, Case No. 2015-CR-03081. My suit against Kansas Election Director Bryan Caskey, Wyandotte County District Court Case Number 2018-CV-000549 was dismissed for improper venue (K.S.A 60-602).

I am eligible to vote under the Laws and Constitution of the United States and Kansas, and vote in nearly all elections, yet my vote is not counted for reasons such as conducting business at a voting address (Johnson County in November 2014, Attachment 1), not being a resident of Wyandotte County (Attachment 2), not having an address "zoned" for voting (Phil Henderson, Kansas City, Kansas Business License Division on 7/17/2018), or not having an attorney when voting (Bruce Newby, Wyandotte County Election Commissioner email to the Wyandotte County DA on 10/25/2017).

I filed complaints with the Secretary of State (SOS) pursuant to K.S.A. 25-2309(c)(iv) but there is no requirement to act. The SOS response: "The voter registration application does not, by statute, permit a business address" (Garrett Roe Deputy Assistant Secretary of State 8/7/2018).

I recommend strengthening prohibitions against state actors obstructing voters, directing the Attorney General to investigate business, zoning or other government false claims, and removing authority from bad government actors. Alternatively, legislate restrictions on Constitutional rights which shall be explicit and precise. What "zone," "business" and "attorney" is required to vote? Irish zones, practicing snake rustling with leprechaun lawyers perhaps?

Dear Mr. Doyle:

The County Board of Canvassers met on Monday, November 18, 2019 to consider the provisional ballots cast in the November 5 General Election in Wyandotte County.

Your provisional ballot was not approved to count by the Board of Canvassers for the reason: Not Registered.

You are not a registered voter in Wyandotte County. A valid Wyandotte County residence address is required for voter registration. A Post Office Box can be used for mail, but it is not sufficient for voter registration.

Your incomplete voter record indicates that you may be enrolled in the Kansas Safe-at-Home Program administered by the Kansas Secretary of State. Voters in the Safe-at-Home Program receive voting ballots from the Kansas Secretary of State.
