Testimony of the Kansas Association of Counties to the Senate Committee on Public Health Proponent testimony on SB 252 • January 23, 2020

Mr. Chairman and Members of the Committee:

Thank you for the opportunity to testify in support of SB 252, which would expand Medicaid (i.e. KanCare) within the state of Kansas. KAC supports expansion of the Kansas Medicaid program to extend healthcare coverage for the physical and behavioral healthcare coverage for at-risk Kansans and supports the pursuit of public health in Kansas.

Medicaid expansion has been a legislative priority for the Association of Counties, as voted on by our membership, since the 2015 legislative session.
