| <p>Nebraska</p> <p>NRS 60-6,298, 60-6,300, 60-6,301</p> | <p>Permits will be issued for a fee of not more than \$25 except:</p> <p>The fee for a continuous / continuing may not exceed \$25 for a 90-day period; \$50 for a 180-day period; \$100 for a 1-year period</p> <p>\$25 for vehicles not exceeding certain weights for a distance up to 120 miles</p> <p>Trucks designed and used exclusively for the collection and transportation of garbage or refuse: \$10 per month or \$100 per year</p> | <p>Exceptions: Vehicles that exceed the maximum load on one axle only but all axles combined are within the limit; certain vehicles or trailers carrying livestock when only one axle exceeds the weight limit; trucks or trailers carrying grain or other seasonally harvested products from the stockpile to the field or the market up to 70 miles.</p> <p>Permits allowed: Vehicles with divisible loads of hay, straw, stover, or bagged livestock bedding; raw milk transporters; compact rubbish transporters</p> |

| <p>Oklahoma</p> <p>Okla Stat §§ 47-14-101, 47-14-103C, 47-14-103D, 47-14-103G, 47-14-109, 47-14-109.3, 47-14-116, 47-14-118, 47-14-118.1</p> | <p>Annual permit for oversize / overweight vehicles: \$4000 for 1 calendar year and in certain circumstances may be transferred to a different vehicle in the fleet</p> <p>Vehicles with permits for loads specific to turbine blades and used for the purpose of wind generation may exceed maximum length limits</p> <p>Annual fleet permit for electric utility or rural electric cooperative: \$4000 for 1 calendar year</p> <p>Annual permit to a transportation company or manufacturer of portable buildings: \$500</p> <p>Certain vehicles transporting rock, sand, gravel, coal, flour, timber, pulpwood, chips in their natural state, oil field fluids or equipment, grain, fertilizer, cottonseed, cotton, livestock, peanuts, canola, sunflowers, soybeans, feed, or other raw agricultural products: Annual special overload permit \$350</p> <p>Utility / refuse vehicles used by counties, towns, or cities or private companies contracted with them; Certain combinations of a wrecker / tower and another vehicle if the wrecker or tower is providing certain services: Annual special overload permit \$100</p> <p>Transportation of overwidth / overheight equipment used in soil conservation work: Annual permit \$25</p> | <p>Annual overweight permits are issued at no cost to municipalities and fire districts for transportation of the firefighting apparatus; owners of implements of husbandry, including tractors, that are temporarily moved on the highway; and retail implement dealers while hauling implements of husbandry</p> <p>Exemptions to permit: vehicles fueled by compressed or liquified natural gas</p> |
