Joint Committee on Federal and State Affairs In support of State Constitutional Amendment reversing Hodes v. Schmidt

Chairman and Members of the Committee,

Good morning. My name is Rochelle Bird. I sit before you today as a woman, mother and concerned Kansan. On behalf of the electorate, I am asking you to provide them the opportunity to shape the policy of their State.

The Hodes vs. Schmidt decision has created a significant policy shift, with the potential of deregulating the abortion industry.
