SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2060 by Representative Parker

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2060 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2060 would permit municipal or county governments to enact an ordinance that would require a private employer to pay compensation for leave from work.

According to the League of Kansas Municipalities and the Kansas Association of Counties, enactment of HB 2060 could have a fiscal effect on State General Fund revenues from income tax collected on wages earned from previously uncompensated leave. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2060 is not reflected in *The FY 2020 Governor's Budget Report*.
