**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2450 by House Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2450 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2450 would amend the Kansas Clean Indoor Air Act to include vaping of tobacco-derived products. The bill would define “electronic cigarette” and include the use of an electronic cigarette to the definition of smoking.

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment states the fiscal effect of HB 2450 would be negligible. Necessary changes to implement the bill would include updating the website, signage redesign to include vaping language, and language changes in outreach materials could all be accomplished within existing resources.
