SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 393 by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 393 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 393 would amend the Net Metering and Easy Connection Act to return the tariff structure to that which existed prior to 2014. The bill would require that utilities offer a tariff or contract to a customer-generator identical to that which would be assigned to a customer that is not a customer-generator, with no additional standby, capacity, interconnection or other fee or charge. According to the bill, any net excess generation credit remaining in a net-metering customer's account at the end of a calendar year would expire. The bill would also make a number of technical corrections to the Act.

According to the Kansas Corporation Commission, enactment of SB 393 would have no fiscal effect on agency operations.
