AN ACT concerning the minimum wage; enacting the Kansas working 1 2 families pay raise act; amending K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 44-1203 and 3 repealing the existing section. 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 44-1203 is hereby amended to read as 6 7 follows: 44-1203. (a) Except as otherwise provided in the minimum wage 8 and maximum hours law, every employer shall pay to each employee 9 wages at a rate as follows: 10 (1) Prior to January 1, 2010, employee wages shall be paid at a rate of 11 not less than \$2.65 an hour; and 12 (2) on and after January 1, 2010, and prior to January 1, 2020, 13 employee wages shall be paid at a rate of not less than \$7.25 an hour; 14 (3) on and after January 1, 2020, and prior to January 1, 2021, 15 employee wages shall be paid at a rate of not less than \$11.00 an hour; 16 and (4) on and after January 1, 2021, employee wages shall be paid at a 17 18 rate of not less than \$15.00 an hour. 19 (b) In calculating such minimum wage rate, an employer may include 20 tips and gratuities received by an employee if such tips and gratuities have 21 customarily constituted part of the remuneration of the employee and if the 22 employee concerned actually received and retained such tips and 23 gratuities. For employees receiving tips and gratuities, the employer shall 24 pay a minimum wage of at least \$2.13 an hour prior to January 1, 2020; at least \$2.63 an hour on and after January 1, 2020, and prior to January 25 26 1, 2021; and at least \$3.13 an hour on and after January 1, 2021. If when 27 combined with the minimum wage rate prescribed in this subsection the 28 amount of the employee's tips and gratuities are: 29 (1) At least equal to \$7.25 an hour the minimum wage rate per hour 30 prescribed by subsection (a), no further payment is required by the 31 employer; or 32 (2) less than <u>\$7.25 an hour</u> the minimum wage rate per hour 33 prescribed by subsection (a), the employer must pay the employee the 34 difference between \$7.25 an hour the minimum wage rate per hour prescribed by subsection (a) and the actual hourly amount received by the 35 36 employee determined by combining the amount of tips and gratuities

received by the employee with the minimum wage prescribed by this 1 subsection paid by the employer. 2

(c) The provisions of this section shall not apply to any employers 3 and employees who are covered under the provisions of the federal fair 4 labor standards act-(, 29 U.S.C.A. U.S.C. § 201 et seq.), and any other acts 5 amendatory thereof or supplemental amendments thereto. 6

(d) The 2019 amendments to this section shall be known as the 7 8 Kansas working families pay raise act.
