AN ACT regulating traffic; concerning the operation of a motor vehicle in a school zone or a construction zone; use of a wireless communication device; amending K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-2118 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

New Section 1. (a) As used in this section:

- (1) "Hands-free device" means speakerphone capability or a telephone attachment or other piece of equipment, regardless of whether permanently installed in the motor vehicle, that allows use of the wireless communication device without use of either of the operator's hands.
- (2) "Wireless communication device" has the same meaning as defined in K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-15,111, and amendments thereto.
- (b) On and after January 1, 2020, no person shall operate a motor vehicle in a school zone established by K.S.A. 8-1560(a), and amendments thereto, or K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-1560e, and amendments thereto, or a road construction zone, as that term is defined in K.S.A. 8-1458a, and amendments thereto, while using a wireless communication device.
 - (c) The provisions of subsection (b) shall not apply to:
- (1) A law enforcement officer or emergency service personnel acting within the course and scope of the law enforcement officer's or emergency service personnel's employment;
 - (2) a motor vehicle that is stopped; or
- (3) a wireless communication device that is being used with a handsfree device.
- (d) The provisions of subsection (b) shall not prohibit a person from using a wireless communication device while operating a motor vehicle in a school zone or road construction zone to:
 - (1) Report current or ongoing illegal activity to law enforcement;
 - (2) prevent imminent injury to a person or property;
 - (3) summon medical or other emergency assistance; or
- (4) relay information between a transit or for-hire operator and the operator's dispatcher, in which the device is permanently affixed to the motor vehicle.
- (e) Any conviction under the provisions of this section shall not be construed as a moving traffic violation for the purpose of K.S.A. 8-255,

and amendments thereto.

- (f) Holding a wireless communication device while operating a motor vehicle in a school zone or a road construction zone shall constitute prima facie evidence of a violation of subsection (b).
- (g) From and after July 1, 2019, and prior to January 1, 2020, a law enforcement officer shall issue a warning citation to anyone violating subsection (b).
- (h) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the uniform act regulating traffic on highways.
 - Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-2118 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-2118. (a) A person charged with a traffic infraction shall, except as provided in subsection (b), appear at the place and time specified in the notice to appear. If the person enters an appearance, waives right to trial, pleads guilty or no contest, the fine shall be no greater than that specified in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs shall be taxed as provided by law.
 - (b) Prior to the time specified in the notice to appear, a person charged with a traffic infraction may enter a written appearance, waive right to trial, plead guilty or no contest and pay the fine for the violation as specified in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs provided by law. Payment may be made in any manner accepted by the court. The traffic citation shall not have been complied with if the payment is not honored for any reason, or if the fine and court costs are not paid in full. When a person charged with a traffic infraction makes payment without executing a written waiver of right to trial and plea of guilty or no contest, the payment shall be deemed such an appearance, waiver of right to trial and plea of no contest.
 - (c) The following uniform fine schedule shall apply uniformly throughout the state but shall not limit the fine which may be imposed following a court appearance, except an appearance made for the purpose of pleading and payment as permitted by subsection (a). The description of offense contained in the following uniform fine schedule is for reference only and is not a legal definition.

n ordinances prohibiting the same offenses. A schedule of fines for all ordinance traffic infractions shall be established by the municipal judge in the manner prescribed by K.S.A. 12-4305, and amendments thereto. Such

fines may vary from those contained in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c).

- (e) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c) shall be doubled if a person is convicted of a traffic infraction, which is defined as a moving violation in accordance with rules and regulations adopted pursuant to K.S.A. 8-249, and amendments thereto, committed within any road construction zone as defined in K.S.A. 8-1458a, and amendments thereto.
- (f) For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, within two years after a prior conviction of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction shall be fined 1½ times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c). For a third violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, within two years, after two prior convictions of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction shall be fined two times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c). For a fourth and each succeeding violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909. and amendments thereto, within two years after three prior convictions of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction shall be fined $2\frac{1}{2}$ times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c).
- (g) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c) relating to exceeding the maximum speed limit, shall be doubled if a person is convicted of exceeding the maximum speed limit in a school zone authorized under K.S.A. 8-1560(a)(4), and amendments thereto.
- (h) For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1556, and amendments thereto, within five years after a prior conviction of K.S.A. 8-1556, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction, shall be fined \$750 for the second violation. For a third and each succeeding violation of K.S.A. 8-1556, and amendments thereto, within five years after two prior convictions of K.S.A. 8-1556, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction, shall be fined \$1,000 for the third and each succeeding violation
 - Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-2118 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
