## HOUSE BILL No. 2522

AN ACT concerning hospitals; relating to rural hospitals; providing grant
 assistance to hospitals in certain counties; establishing the rural hospital
 innovation grant program; rural hospital innovation grant fund.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) As used in this section:

7 (1) "Eligible county" means a county in Kansas other than Douglas,8 Johnson, Sedgwick, Shawnee or Wyandotte county.

9 (2) "Hospital" means the same as defined in K.S.A. 65-425, and 10 amendments thereto.

11 "Transitional assistance" means any assistance related to changing (3)12 a hospital's current healthcare delivery model to a model more appropriate 13 for the community that the hospital serves, including, but not limited to: Conducting a market study of healthcare services needed and provided in 14 the community; acquiring and implementing new technological tools and 15 16 infrastructure, including, but not limited to, telemedicine delivery methods; and acquiring the services of appropriate personnel, including, 17 18 but not limited to, additional medical residents or individuals trained to be 19 needed healthcare professionals.

20 (b) (1) There is established the rural hospital innovation grant 21 program to be administered by the secretary of health and environment. 22 The program, and any grant awarded thereunder, shall be for the purpose 23 of strengthening and improving the healthcare system and increasing 24 access to healthcare services in eligible counties to help communities in 25 such counties achieve and maintain optimal health by providing 26 transitional assistance to hospitals in such counties. The secretary may 27 award a rural hospital innovation grant to a county that applies in 28 accordance with this section.

29 (2) The secretary of health and environment may award a grant under 30 this section only if the amount of state moneys to be awarded in the grant 31 has been matched by private stakeholders, including hospital foundations 32 or other organizations, contributing to the secretary for the program, on a 33 basis of \$2 of private stakeholder moneys for every \$1 of state moneys. The secretary of health and environment may receive moneys by bequest, 34 35 donation or gift to fulfill the public-private match of moneys required 36 under this paragraph. Any such moneys received shall be remitted to the

state treasurer in accordance with K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments
 thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state treasurer shall
 deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit of the rural
 hospital innovation grant fund.

5 (3) The board of county commissioners of an eligible county, or the 6 board's designee, may apply to the secretary for a rural hospital innovation 7 grant in the form and manner prescribed by the secretary of health and 8 environment. Such application shall include:

9 (A) A description of the hospital for which the grant moneys will be 10 expended, including the name and location of the hospital;

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(B) a statement of the amount of grant moneys requested;

12 (C) a description of the needs of the hospital, the transitional 13 assistance for which the grant moneys will be expended and how such 14 transitional assistance will meet the stated needs; and

15 (D) any other information that the secretary deems necessary to 16 administer this section.

(4) Prior to awarding any grant moneys to an eligible county under
this section, the secretary shall enter into a written agreement with the
county requiring that the county:

20 (A) Expend any such grant moneys to provide transitional assistance 21 to a hospital in the eligible county, as approved by the secretary;

(B) no later than one year after any such grant moneys are awarded,
 report to the secretary detailing the effect that such grant is having on
 health and other outcomes in the eligible county and the affected
 community;

(C) repay all awarded grant moneys to the secretary if the county fails
to satisfy any material term or condition of the grant agreement; and

(D) any other terms and conditions that the secretary deems necessaryto administer this section.

30 (c) (1) There is established in the state treasury the rural hospital 31 innovation grant fund to be administered by the secretary of health and 32 environment. All moneys credited to the fund shall be used only for 33 purposes related to the rural hospital innovation grant program. All 34 expenditures from the fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation 35 acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant 36 to vouchers approved by the secretary of health and environment or the 37 secretary's designee.

(2) On July 1, 2020, the director of accounts and reports shall transfer
\$10,000,000 from the state general fund to the rural hospital innovation
grant fund.

41 (d) The secretary of health and environment shall adopt rules and 42 regulations as necessary to implement and administer this section.

43 (e) (1) On or before October 1 of each year, for each rural hospital

innovation grant awarded under this section, the county shall prepare and
 submit to the secretary of health and environment a report describing: The
 amount and stated purposes of any awarded grant moneys; the fulfillment

4 of the terms and conditions of the grant agreement; and the transitional
5 assistance upon which the moneys have been spent.

6 (2) On or before February 1 of each year, the secretary shall compile 7 the information received under this subsection and submit a report to the 8 governor and the legislature including such information and a description 9 of and reasoning for any applications for a rural hospital innovation grant 10 that the secretary has denied.

11 (f) (1) The rural hospital innovation grant program shall expire on 12 June 30, 2024.

(2) On July 1, 2024:

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(A) The director of accounts and reports shall transfer all moneys inthe rural hospital innovation grant fund to the state general fund;

16 (B) all liabilities of the rural hospital innovation grant fund shall be 17 transferred to and imposed on the state general fund; and

(C) the rural hospital innovation grant fund shall be abolished.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after itspublication in the statute book.
