31	accounts and reports is hereby authorized and directed to draw warrants on
32	the state treasurer in favor of the claimants specified in this act, upon
33	vouchers duly executed by the state agencies directed to pay the amounts
34	specified in such sections to the claimants or their legal representatives or
35	duly authorized agents, as provided by law.
36	(b) The director of accounts and reports shall secure prior to the
37	payment of any amount to any claimant, other than amounts authorized to
38	be paid pursuant to section 7 as motor-vehicle fuel tax refunds or as
39	transactions between state agencies as provided by this act, a written
40	release and satisfaction of all claims and rights against the state of Kansas
41	and any agencies, officers and employees of the state of Kansas regarding
42 43	their respective claims. Sec. 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
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1 publication in the statute book.
