1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION ratifying the May 9, 2019, State of
2 Disaster Emergency declaration issued by Governor Laura Kelly and
3 providing for the continuation thereof for certain Kansas counties until
4 January 13, 2020.

5 WHEREAS, On May 9, 2019, Governor Laura Kelly issued a State of
6 Disaster Emergency declaration in response to severe storms and flooding
7 in the counties of Barber, Chase, Clark, Cowley, Geary, Greenwood,
8 Harvey, Marion, Meade, Neosho, Osage, Ottawa, Reno, Rice and
9 Sumner, and has since amended the declaration to include a total of 56
10 counties: Now, therefore,

11 *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Kansas,*
12 *the Senate concurring therein:* That the State of Disaster Emergency
13 declaration issued on May 9, 2019, as amended, for the counties of Allen,
14 Anderson, Barber, Barton, Butler, Chase, Chautauqua, Cherokee, Clark,
15 Clay, Cloud, Coffey, Comanche, Cowley, Crawford, Dickinson,
16 Doniphan, Douglas, Elk, Ellsworth, Franklin, Geary, Greenwood, Harper,
17 Harvey, Hodgeman, Jefferson, Kingman, Leavenworth, Lincoln, Linn,
18 Lyon, Marion, Marshall, McPherson, Meade, Montgomery, Morris,
19 Neosho, Osage, Ottawa, Pawnee, Phillips, Pottawatomie, Pratt, Reno,
20 Rice, Riley, Rush, Russell, Saline, Sumner, Wabaunsee, Washington,
21 Wilson, Woodson, and any other county designated by the Governor in
22 accordance with K.S.A. 48-924, and amendments thereto, by amendment
23 to the May 9, 2019, declaration is hereby ratified and continued in force
24 and effect on and after May 9, 2019, through January 13, 2020, subject to
25 extension by the State Finance Council in accordance with K.S.A. 48-
26 924(b)(3), and amendments thereto.
