AN ACT concerning open government; relating to the attorney general; legal representation or indemnification in alleged violations of the open records act or the open meetings act; amending K.S.A. 45-215 and K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 75-4317 and repealing the existing sections.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

New Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of the Kansas tort claims act, K.S.A. 75-6101 et seq., and amendments thereto, or any other provision of law to the contrary, the attorney general may refuse to provide legal representation to or indemnification of a public agency or employee or agent of a public agency in an action, proceeding or investigation involving an alleged violation of the Kansas open records act, K.S.A. 45-215 et seq., and amendments thereto. The provisions of K.S.A. 75-6108(d), and amendments thereto, shall not apply to a refusal under this section.

New Sec. 2. Notwithstanding any provision of the Kansas tort claims act, K.S.A. 75-6101 et seq., and amendments thereto, or any other provision of law to the contrary, the attorney general may refuse to provide legal representation to or indemnification of a public agency or employee or agent of a public agency in an action, proceeding or investigation involving an alleged violation of the Kansas open meetings act, K.S.A. 75-4317 et seq., and amendments thereto. The provisions of K.S.A. 75-6108(d), and amendments thereto, shall not apply to a refusal under this section.

Sec. 3. K.S.A. 45-215 is hereby amended to read as follows: 45-215. K.S.A. 45-215 through 45-223 45-229, and amendments thereto, and K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 45-230 through 45-254 and section 1, and amendments thereto, shall be known and may be cited as the open records act.

- Sec. 4. K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 75-4317 is hereby amended to read as follows: 75-4317. (a) In recognition of the fact that a representative government is dependent upon an informed electorate, it is declared to be the policy of this state that meetings for the conduct of governmental affairs and the transaction of governmental business be open to the public.
- (b) It is declared hereby to be against the public policy of this state for any such meeting to be adjourned to another time or place in order to subvert the policy of open public meetings as pronounced in subsection

- (c) K.S.A. 75-4317 through 75-4320a, and amendments thereto, and K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 75-4320b through 75-4320f and section 2, and amendments thereto, shall be known and may be cited as the open meetings act.

- Sec. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
