2	amending K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 32-988 and repealing the existing section.

4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
5	Section 1. K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 32-988 is hereby amended to read as
6	follows: 32-988. (a) The secretary is authorized to adopt, in accordance
7	with K.S.A. 32-805, and amendments thereto, rules and regulations fixing
8	the amount of fees for the following items, subject to the following
9	limitations and subject to the requirement that no such rules and
10	regulations shall be adopted as temporary rules and regulations:
11	Big game permits
12	Resident (other than elk permit): maximum \$100
13	Nonresident (other than elk permit): maximum \$400 \$600
14	Elk permit: maximum \$350 \$500
15	Nonresident mule deer stamp: maximum \$150 \$250
16	Nonresident applications: maximum \$25 \$40
17	Combination hunting and fishing licenses
18	Resident: maximum <del>\$50</del> \$100
19	Lifetime: maximum \$1,000 \$1,500; or 8 quarterly payments, each

10 (b) The fee for a landowner-tenant resident big game or wild turkey 11 hunting permit shall be an amount equal to  $\frac{1}{2}$  the fee for a general resident 12 big game or wild turkey hunting permit.

13 (c) The fee for a big game or wild turkey hunting permit for a resident 14 under 16 years of age shall be an amount not to exceed  $\frac{1}{2}$  the fee for a 15 general resident big game or wild turkey hunting permit.

(d) The fee for a furharvester license for a resident under 16 years of
age shall be an amount-equal to not to exceed <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> the fee for a resident
furharvester license.

(e) For a resident who is at least 65 years of age, but less than 75years of age:

21 (1) The fee for an annual hunting license shall be an amount equal to  $\frac{1}{2}$  the fee for a general annual hunting license;

23 (2) the fee for an annual fishing license shall be an amount equal to  $\frac{1}{2}$ 24 the fee for a general annual fishing license; and

25 (3) the fee for an annual combination hunting and fishing license 26 shall be an amount equal to  $\frac{1}{2}$  the fee for a general annual combination 27 hunting and fishing license.

(f) The secretary may establish, by rules and regulations adopted in
accordance with K.S.A. 32-805, and amendments thereto, different fees for
various classes and types of licenses, permits, stamps and other issuances
of the department-which *that* may occur within each item as described
under subsection (a).

(g) The provisions of subsection (e) shall expire on June 30, 2020.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 32-988 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
