SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2493

As Recommended by House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice

Brief*

HB 2493 would make changes to Kansas Sentencing Commission (Commission) membership by requiring Senate members who serve on the Commission to also serve on the Senate Committee on Judiciary and House members who serve on the Commission to also serve on the House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice.

Background

The bill was introduced by the House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice at the request of the Commission.

In the House Committee hearing, a representative of the Commission testified in support of the bill, indicating this bill would provide support to the Commission, with members having prior experience with the types of topics its discusses. No other testimony was provided.

According to the fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget on the bill, the Legislative Coordinating Council and Commission both indicate enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect.
