5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 46-235 is hereby amended to read as follows: 46-
7 235. (a) *Except as provided in subsection (b)*, no state officer or employee
8 shall accept compensation for performance of official duties, other than
9 that to which such person is entitled for such performance. No person shall
10 pay or offer to pay any state officer or employee any compensation for
11 performance of official duties, except a state officer or employee
12 performing official duties in making payments to state officers and
13 employees. The receipt of wages or salary from an individual's non-state
14 employer during a period of service as a state officer or employee shall not
15 be construed as compensation for performance of official duties.

16 (b) *Legislative assistants and committee assistants may accept gifts*
17 *each fiscal year from an individual legislator for whom they work or*
18 *legislative committee chairperson or vice chairperson of not to exceed a*
19 *total of ~~\$120~~ **\$150**.*

(c) Prior to the end of each legislative session, the division of legislative administrative services shall provide to each legislator a form to report the amount of money given by such legislator as a gift to any legislative assistant or committee assistant.
