Representative Barker and Members of the Committee:

My name is Midge Grinstead, and I am the Kansas State Director for The Humane Society of the United States (HSUS). On behalf of our members, and advocates in Kansas, we stand neutral on HB 2740

HB 2740 will remove greyhounds from the Ks Expanded Lottery Act (KELA) and the Ks Parimutuel Racing Act (KPRA). This is important because greyhound racing is an inhumane activity that has been largely rejected by your constituents and the American public. They simply don't attend these races. Kansas tracks suffered significant loses before the last one closed in August of 2008. Greyhound racing has economically failed everywhere.

Prior to 2012, greyhounds weren't considered dogs and not given the same protection as other pet animals. The treatment of greyhounds used in commercial racing was and is overseen by their own industry. They promote and tolerate an overproduction of dogs, resulting in an annual surplus numbering in the thousands, many of whom will end up being destroyed despite the best efforts of shelters and rescue groups.

There are currently only three states with operating tracks in the U.S. West Virginia, Iowa and Texas. There are 40 states that no longer allow or don't have provisions in their state to allow live commercial greyhound racing.

As a past shelter director and current board member for the Kansas Animal Control Association, I can tell you that these animal welfare concerns not only impact greyhounds, but the state as well. Public and private agencies will be forced to absorb the costs of investigating related cruelty complaints, taking in dogs with injuries and illness for treatment, rescue and adoption, and picking up dead discarded bodies of dogs dumped when the racing industry is done with them, as I have witnessed in the past.
