Subject: **SB 335** – Exempting certain business entities that provide health insurance in the state but are not subject to the jurisdiction of the commissioner of insurance from the payment of the annual premium tax.

SB 335 amends K.S.A. 40-2222b, pertaining to business entities that offer association health plans. The bill was passed by the Senate Committee of the Whole on February 17, 2022 and referred to this committee on February 17, 2022.

The bill creates an exception from payment of the annual premium tax for business entities described in K.S.A. 40-2222 that provide coverage in the state of Kansas for medical, surgical, chiropractic, physical therapy, speech pathology, audiology, professional mental health, dental, hospital, or optometric expenses through self-funded health insurance.
