Closing or restricting a business due to enforcement of health and safety concerns - such as sanitary conditions, structural safety, workplace safety may also be included in the refund request.

Morton	House Bill No. 2142 also directs the funds to be made from a county's general fund, but doesn't limit refunds to only county's share of taxes. All taxing districts, including the state, school district and municipalities, are to refunded by the county with no authorized recovery mechanism in place for counties to ever be made whole. Our counties don't have that kind of money sitting in an unencumbered account.
