Chairman Smith, Vice Chairman Mason, Ranking Member Gartner, and Members of the Committee,

Thank you for the opportunity to provide testimony in support of HB 2265: Providing a sales tax exemption for required textbooks and authorizing a local sales tax on required textbooks.
