Subject: Senate Bill No. 67

Summary

Senate Bill No. 67 amends the definitions of all-terrain vehicles and recreational off-highway vehicles.

“All-terrain vehicle” will now be allowed up to 55 inches (from 50) and measured from the “the outside of one tire rim to the outside of the other tire rim.” Additionally, “Recreational off-highway vehicle” would be allowed up to 75 inches (from 64) and the dry weight increased from 2,000 to 3,500 pounds.
