2 providing that all vehicles that are more than 35 years old qualify as
3 antique vehicles for registration purposes; ~~eliminating references to~~

7 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

8 Section 1. K.S.A. 2020 Supp. 8-166 is hereby amended to read as
9 follows: 8-166. The following words and phrases when used in this act
10 shall for the purpose of this act have the following meaning:

11 (a) "Antique" means any vehicle, including an antique military
12 vehicle, more than 35 years old, propelled by a motor using petroleum
13 fuel, steam or electricity, or any combination thereof, *regardless of the age*
14 *or type of the components or equipment installed on the vehicle.*

15 (b) "Person" means every natural person, firm, copartnership,
16 association, corporation, club or organization.

17 (c) "Antique military vehicle" means a vehicle, regardless of the
18 vehicle's size or weight, ~~which that~~ was manufactured for use in any
19 country's military forces and is maintained to represent its military design,
20 except that an antique military vehicle shall not include a fully tracked
21 vehicle.

22 (d) The words and phrases defined in K.S.A. 8-126 and 8-126a, and
23 amendments thereto, when used in this act, shall ~~have the meanings~~
24 ~~respectively ascribed to them~~ *mean the same as defined* by such sections.

25 ~~Sec. 2. K.S.A. 8-194 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-194.~~
26 ~~As used in this act: (a) "Collector" means the owner of one or more~~
27 ~~special interest vehicles or street rod vehicles who acquires, collects,~~
28 ~~purchases, trades or disposes of such vehicles or parts therefor for~~
29 ~~such person's own use in order to restore, preserve and maintain such~~
30 ~~vehicle or vehicles for historic interest.~~

31 (b) "Parts car" means a ~~motor vehicle generally in nonoperable~~
32 ~~condition which that is owned by a collector to furnish parts which that~~
33 ~~will enable the collector to restore, preserve and maintain a special~~
34 ~~interest vehicle, street rod vehicle or antique vehicle.~~

35 (c) "Special interest vehicle" means a ~~motor vehicle which that is~~
36 ~~more than 20 years of age and which that has not been altered or~~

1 ~~modified from the original manufacturer's specifications except to~~
2 ~~assure normal running operation or to meet specific safety inspection~~
3 ~~requirements on original equipment, or both. "Special interest vehicle"~~
4 ~~shall also mean and include a motor vehicle manufactured before 1949 that~~
5 ~~when altered or modified is referred to as a "street rod."~~

6 ~~Sec. 3. K.S.A. 8-195 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-195.~~

7 ~~(a) Any person who is the owner of a special interest vehicle or street~~
8 ~~rod vehicle at the time of making application for registration or~~
9 ~~transfer of title of the vehicle may upon application register the same~~
10 ~~as a special interest vehicle or street rod vehicle upon payment of an~~
11 ~~annual fee of \$26 and be furnished each year upon the payment of~~
12 ~~such fee license plates of a distinctive design in lieu of the usual license~~
13 ~~plates which, and such plates shall show, in addition to the~~
14 ~~identification number, that the vehicle is a special interest vehicle or~~
15 ~~that the vehicle is a special interest vehicle and it meets the qualifications~~
16 ~~of a street rod, as the case may be, owned by a Kansas collector. The~~
17 ~~registration shall be valid for one year and may be renewed by~~
18 ~~payment of such annual fee. Special interest vehicles including street~~
19 ~~rod vehicles may be used as are other vehicles of the same type, except~~
20 ~~that special interest vehicles including street rod vehicles may not~~
21 ~~transport passengers for hire, nor haul material weighing more than~~
22 ~~500 pounds.~~

23 ~~(b) Each collector applying for special interest vehicle or street rod~~
24 ~~vehicle license plates will be issued a collector's identification number~~
25 ~~which that will appear on each license plate. Second and all subsequent~~
26 ~~registrations under this section by the same collector will bear the~~
27 ~~same collector's identification number followed by a suffix letter for~~
28 ~~vehicle identification.~~

29 ~~(c) A collector must own and have registered one or more vehicles~~
30 ~~with regular license plates which that are used for regular~~
31 ~~transportation.~~

32 ~~Sec. 4. K.S.A. 8-196 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-196.~~
33 ~~In addition to the fee in K.S.A. 8-195, as amended and amendments~~
34 ~~thereto, there shall be an original (first time only) processing fee of \$20~~
35 ~~to defray the cost of issuing the original collector's special interest~~
36 ~~vehicle license plates or special interest vehicles with street rod~~
37 ~~designation license plates and to ensure that each collector will shall be~~
38 ~~issued only one collector's identification number.~~

39 ~~Sec. 2. 5. K.S.A. 8-194, 8-195 and 8-196 and K.S.A. 2020 Supp. 8-~~
40 ~~166 is are hereby repealed.~~
