

We live in the footprint of the Irish Creek Windfarm in Marshall County, Kansas. The wind farm has been in operation for approximately 2 months. We are non participating residents. We are very disappointed in the placement of these turbines. We have six within a mile of our home. We find the noise disturbing, draining and wearing. We have observed shadow flicker within our house as well as on the outbuildings on our property. We feel invaded. The closest turbine is 2400 feet from our foundation.

The non participants in the footprint feel that we were abused and not represented at all by the county commissioners. Taxation without representation. We asked for at least 3000 foot setbacks, however we were denied that request. We begged for more time by issuing a moratorium, and this fell on deaf ears.

Please please consider giving nonparticipants a break and passing SB353. It is too late for us, but we hope that the state can make life easier for others in the future.
