- 1) These categories are counted by arrest. No offense report is necessary for these crimes.
- 2) Liquor Violations include Minor in Possession, open container, and sale to a minor, among others.
- 3) These categories are counted by offense. They are counted as such when the local agency marks the report as offender suspected of using alcohol. Violent Offenses are counted by victim with the exception of Robbery, which is counted by incident.
- 4) Disorderly conduct does not require an offense report so this number only includes those where agency chose to send offense report.

Caveats:

Violent offenses are counted by victim with the exception of Robbery which is counted by incident. These numbers do not include agencies reporting summary data. See below for listing of agencies.
