Good afternoon,

Attached is follow-up information from Mark Tallman regarding the KASB dues questions he was asked by the Committee.

Cassandra Barton has also provided the graduation rates for different student cohorts:

Students who attended Insight for entire high school career:

- For the 2020 graduating class, 10 of the 13 students who attended Insight for their entire high school career graduated with their 4-year cohort (77.0 percent graduation rate); and
- For the 2021 graduating class, 32 of the 36 students who attended Insight for their entire high school career graduated with their 4-year cohort (88.0 percent graduation rate).

Special Education Students

- For the 2020 class, 12 of the 96 graduates were special education students (12.5 percent); and
- For the 2021 class, 36 of the 157 graduates were special education students (23.0 percent).

Additional information is still expected from KSDE and USD 500.
