
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2100 by Representative Rhiley

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2100 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2100 would designate bridge number 0018-0089 located on U.S. Highway 166 in Cowley County as the "SGT Tyler A Juden Memorial Bridge." The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) would be required to place signs to indicate this designation.

KDOT estimates that it would cost \$2,860 to manufacture and install two signs for the bridge designated in the bill (\$1,430 for each sign). However, current law requires that sufficient gifts and donations be received by KDOT prior to installing the signs to reimburse the agency for the initial cost, plus an additional 50.0 percent of the initial cost to defray future sign maintenance. Altogether, \$4,290 would need to be received from donations to install the signs. KDOT indicates that implementation of the bill would require an increase of \$2,860 to the expenditure limitation for the agency operations account in FY 2022. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2100 is not reflected in *The FY 2022 Governor's Budget Report*.
