
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 363 by Senate Committee on Education

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 363 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 363 would require school districts to publish annually on the school district's website a list of training materials and activities used for student instruction and teacher professional development at each school of the school district. The publication would include a list by grade level and area of instruction of the learning materials, the procedures used to review, document, or approve the materials or activities, and a list of all material used for teacher professional development.

According to the Department of Education, the enactment of SB 363 would have no fiscal effect on state aid to school districts. However, the Department notes that there could be significant administrative costs of local school districts to comply with the requirements of the bill.
