AN ACT concerning elections; relating to prosecution of election crimes; 1 2 duties of the secretary of state; amending K.S.A. 2020 Supp. 25-2435 and repealing the existing section. 3 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 2020 Supp. 25-2435 is hereby amended to read as 6 7 follows: 25-2435. (a) Independent authority to prosecute any person who 8 has committed-or, attempted to commit or conspired to commit any act that 9 constitutes a Kansas elections crime defined in K.S.A. 25-1128, and amendments thereto, or article 24 of chapter 25 of the Kansas Statutes 10 11 Annotated, and amendments thereto, shall be vested in: 12 (1) The *appropriate* county or district attorney-or county attorney of 13 the county where such act occurred; or (2) the Kansas attorney general; or 14 (3) the Kansas secretary of state at the request of a county or 15 16 district attorney. (b) If one of the officers listed in subsection (a) has commenced the 17 18 prosecution of a person who has committed or attempted to commit any 19 act that constitutes a Kansas election crime, the other officers listed in-20 subsection (a) may provide assistance to the prosecuting officer but shall 21 not commence a separate prosecution the secretary of state becomes aware 22 of evidence of any elections crime as described in subsection (a), the 23 secretary of state shall promptly inform the attorney general and the appropriate county or district attorney of such evidence. Upon request of 24 25 the attorney general or the appropriate county or district attorney, or the 26 attorney general if the county or district attorney has requested assistance from the attorney general, the secretary of state shall 27 28 cooperate and provide assistance in the investigation or prosecution of 29 any such crime. 30 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2020 Supp. 25-2435 is hereby repealed.

31 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 32 publication in the statute book.
