## **House Concurrent Resolution No. 5032**

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION honoring the commitment and 1 2 resilience of the Ukrainian people fighting against the Russian 3 invasion. 4 5 WHEREAS, Ukraine is a free, democratic, independent and sovereign nation with its own distinctive culture and language; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Many of the pioneers who settled in the state of Kansas came from the land that is now Ukraine, creating a special bond 8 9 between this state and that country; and 10 WHEREAS, In 2014, Russian armed forces and their proxies annexed and occupied portions of the lands of Ukraine in violation of its 11 12 national sovereignty and international law; and 13 WHEREAS, On the morning of February 24, 2022, naval, air and ground forces of the Russian Federation launched a premeditated and 14 15 unprovoked attack on the people and the nation of Ukraine with the 16 intent to subjugate and occupy a free and democratic nation; and 17 WHEREAS, Russian leadership appears to be targeting civilian homes and buildings in violation of international law; and 18 19 WHEREAS, Numerous Russian citizens have opposed the actions of 20 their leaders and have shown courage by publicly protesting against 2.1 those leaders; and 22 WHEREAS, The people of Ukraine have demonstrated the role of a 23 well-armed citizenry in standing against invasion and protecting life 24 and property; and 25 WHEREAS, We honor and recognize the commitment of the Ukrainian people to strengthen and protect the country's borders from invasion 26 27 and to fight for their homeland; and WHEREAS, In Ukraine's time of need, the people of Kansas must 28 support the people of Ukraine in fighting for their nation and right to 29 30 exist as a separate and distinct country with its own identity and 31 independence: Now, therefore, 32 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Kansas, the Senate concurring therein: That we stand in solidarity with the 33 Ukrainian people and honor their commitment and resilience in 34 35 fighting against Russia; and

Be it further resolved: That we condemn the Russian invasion of the

nation of Ukraine and all attempts to establish tyranny over other 1 2 sovereign nations; and Be it further resolved: That we urge the United States federal government, the member states of the North Atlantic Treaty 3 4 Organization and all freedom loving countries of the world to provide aid and support to the Ukrainian people in their struggle against this 5 6 7 aggression; and Be it further resolved: That the Secretary of State shall send an enrolled copy of this resolution to the Ukrainian and Russian ambassadors to 8 9 the United States, to each member of the Kansas Congressional 10 delegation and three enrolled copies to Representative Ryckman. 11
