1 AN ACT concerning elections; relating to voter registration; authorizing
2 registration for individuals 16 years of age or older; amending K.S.A.
3 25-2306 and repealing the existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 25-2306 is hereby amended to read as follows: 25-
7 2306. ~~The application for registration shall include a statement by the~~
8 ~~applicant that he will have reached the age of eighteen (18) years before~~
9 ~~the next statewide general election~~ (a) *Any person 16 years of age or older*
10 *may apply to register to vote. If the applicant is under 18 years of age, the*
11 *secretary of state shall suspend such applicant's registration until such*
12 *time as the person reaches 18 years of age.*

13 (b) *No person may vote at any election until—~~he~~ such person has*
14 *reached the age of eighteen (18) 18 years of age.*

15 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 25-2306 is hereby repealed.

16 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
17 publication in the statute book.
