1 AN ACT making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal years ending
2 June 30, 2021, June 30, 2022, June 30, 2023, June 30, 2024, June 30,
3 2025, June 30, 2026, June 30, 2027, June 30, 2028, June 30, 2029, June
4 30, 2030, June 30, 2031, and June 30, 2032, for state agencies;
5 authorizing certain transfers, capital improvement projects and fees,
6 imposing certain restrictions and limitations, and directing or
7 authorizing certain receipts, disbursements, procedures and acts
8 incidental to the foregoing; amending K.S.A. 75-4209 and K.S.A. 2020
9 Supp. 2-223 and repealing the existing sections.

11 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

12 Section 1. (a) For the fiscal years ending June 30, 2021, June 30,
13 2022, June 30, 2023, June 30, 2024, June 30, 2025, June 30, 2026, June
14 30, 2027, June 30, 2028, June 30, 2029, June 30, 2030, June 30, 2031, and
15 June 30, 2032, appropriations are hereby made, restrictions and limitations
16 are hereby imposed, and transfers, capital improvement projects, fees,
17 receipts, disbursements, procedures and acts incidental to the foregoing are
18 hereby directed or authorized as provided in this act.

19 (b) The agencies named in this act are hereby authorized to initiate
20 and complete the capital improvement projects specified and authorized by
21 this act or for which appropriations are made by this act, subject to the
22 restrictions and limitations imposed by this act.

23 (c) This act shall not be subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 75-
24 6702(a), and amendments thereto.

25 (d) The appropriations made in this act shall not be subject to the
26 provisions of K.S.A. 46-155, and amendments thereto.

35 (2) repurchase agreements with a bank or a primary government
36 securities dealer which reports to the market reports division of the federal
37 reserve bank of New York for direct obligations of, or obligations that are
38 insured as to principal and interest by, the United States government or any
39 agency thereof and obligations and securities of United States government
40 sponsored enterprises which under federal law may be accepted as security
41 for public funds;

42 (3) commercial paper that does not exceed 270 days to maturity and
43 which has received one of the two highest commercial paper credit ratings

1 by a nationally recognized investment rating firm; and

2 (4) corporate bonds which have received one of the two highest
3 ratings by a nationally recognized investment rating firm.

4 (b) When moneys are available for deposit or investments, the
5 director of investments may invest in SKILL act projects and bonds
6 pursuant to K.S.A. 74-8920, and amendments thereto, and in state agency
7 bonds and bond projects.

8 (c) When moneys are available for deposits or investments, the
9 director of investments may invest in preferred stock of Kansas venture
10 capital, inc., under terms and conditions prescribed by K.S.A. 74-8203,
11 and amendments thereto, but such investments shall not in the aggregate
12 exceed a total amount of \$10,000,000.

13 (d) When moneys are available for deposits or investments, the
14 director of investments may invest in loans pursuant to legislative
15 mandates, except that not more than the greater of 10% or \$140,000,000 of
16 the state moneys shall be invested. The provisions of this subsection shall
17 not apply to the provisions of subsection (m).

18 (e) Interest on investment accounts in banks is to be paid at maturity,
19 but not less than annually.

20 (f) Investments made by the director of investments under the
21 provisions of this section shall be made with judgment and care, under
22 circumstances then prevailing, which persons of prudence, discretion and
23 intelligence exercise in the management of their own affairs, not for
24 speculation, but for investment, considering the probable safety of their
25 capital as well as the probable income to be derived.

26 (g) Investments under subsection (a) or (b) or under K.S.A. 75-4237,
27 and amendments thereto, shall be for a period not to exceed four years,
28 except that linked deposits authorized under the provisions of K.S.A. 2-
29 3703 through 2-3707, and amendments thereto, shall not exceed a period
30 of 10 years; agricultural production loan deposits authorized under the
31 provisions of K.S.A. 75-4268 through 75-4274, and amendments thereto,
32 shall not exceed a period of eight years and housing loan deposits
33 authorized under K.S.A. 75-4276 through 75-4282, and amendments
34 thereto, shall not exceed a period of five years or 20 years, as applicable

36 (h) Investments in securities under subsection (a)(1) shall be limited
37 to securities which do not have any more interest rate risk than do direct

42 for investment under subsection (a), in the municipal investment pool

1 (j) The director of investments shall not invest moneys in the pooled

3 "derivatives" means a financial contract whose value depends on the value

6 portfolio shall be invested and reinvested by the director of investments in
7 accordance with investment policies developed, approved, published and
8 updated on an annual basis by the board. Such investment policies shall
9 include at a minimum guidelines which identify credit standards, eligible
10 instruments, allowable maturity ranges, methods for valuing the portfolio,
11 calculating earnings and yields and limits on portfolio concentration for
12 each type of investment. Any changes in such investment policies shall be
