AN ACT concerning education; providing ACT college entrance exams
 and workkeys assessments to nonpublic school students; notification
 thereof; report to the legislature; amending K.S.A. 2020 Supp. 72-5179
 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 2020 Supp. 72-5179 is hereby amended to read as follows: 72-5179. (a) The state board of education shall provide the ACT 8 9 college entrance exam and the three ACT workkeys assessments that are 10 required to earn a national career readiness certificate to each student 11 enrolled in grades 11 and 12, and the pre-ACT college entrance exam to 12 each student enrolled in grade nine. No student shall be required to pay 13 any fees or costs to take any such exam or assessments. The state board shall not be required to provide more than one exam and three assessments 14 for each student. The state board of education may enter into any contracts 15 16 that are necessary to promote statewide cost savings to administer such exams and assessments. 17

18 (b) The Kansas department of education and each school district 19 shall annually notify the official custodian of every nonaccredited private 20 secondary school registered with the department pursuant to K.S.A. 72-21 4346, and amendments thereto, of publish on their websites the times. dates and locations of the pre-ACT college entrance exam, the ACT 22 23 college entrance exam and the ACT workkeys assessments that are offered 24 in Kansas and information for students on how to register for such 25 exams or assessments.

(c) Participation in the pre-ACT college entrance exam, the ACT
college entrance exam or the ACT workkeys assessment shall be
optional. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require any
student to participate in such exams or assessments.

30 (c)(d) On or before the first day of each regular legislative session, 31 the state board of education shall prepare and submit a report to the 32 senate standing committee on education and the house standing committee 33 or any successor committees on education that includes the aggregate 34 exam and assessment data for all students who were provided the exams 35 and assessments pursuant to this section.

36 (d)(e) As used in this section, "student" means any person who is
