## SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 160

# As Amended by House Committee on Agriculture

#### **Brief\***

SB 160, as amended, would update the reference in current law to the guidelines of the American Fisheries Society from special publication number 30 to special publication number 35.

The bill would be in effect upon publication in the Kansas Register.

## **Background**

The bill was introduced by the Senate Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources at the request of Senator Kerschen on behalf of the Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism (KDWPT).

## Senate Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources

In the Senate Committee hearing, the Secretary of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism provided **proponent** testimony stating the bill would update the valuation process for illegally commercialized fish and mussels and update the reference to the American Fisheries Society guidelines to the most recent special publication.

No other testimony was provided.
