 Add \$58,859, all from the SGF, for a staff salary adjustment for FY 2022. The Committee notes the salary is necessary to maintain a stable and experienced workforce, reduce staff turnover, attract qualified personnel, and maintain a more-competitive peerbaseline. The Committee further notes the agency has 10.0 FTE positions who serve adults who are without family or financial resources and who, through either physical or mental impairment of disability, are identified as in need of a court-appointed guardian or conservator.
