FY 2013 Budget


We support the Governor's budget recommendation

- Veterinary Medicine improvement/expansion \$5 million
- NBAF preparation \$5 million
- Engineering expansion program \$3.5 million
- Animal health research \$5 million (2nd year)
- Kansas Comprehensive Grant backfill \$1 million
- Rehabilitation and repair \$20 million

Challenges

- Retain best and brightest faculty
- Average faculty salary remains at bottom of Big 12
- Keep tuition affordable
- Tuition and fees ranks 8th in Big 12
- Fund expense mandates
- Benefits increase, GHI and classified retirement
- Faculty promotions and professorships
- Utilities rate increases
- Maintain aging buildings

2+2 Agreements in Kansas



Accomplishments

- Record enrollment of 23,863 Students
- 2010-2011 bachelor's graduates
- 92% of graduates employed or pursuing further education
- 71% employed in Kansas or Kansas City metro
- Ad Astra Kansas Initiative
- Named 21 active faculty members among top 150 researchers in Kansas history
- Student champions
- Crops team wins 3rd national championship in a row
- Student robotics team wins 5th straight international contest

Accomplishments

- Extension outreach
- 60,000 Kansans in SNAP-Ed family nutrition program
- Implemented Flint Hills smoke management plan
- Irrigation research to conserve Ogallala aquifer
- National beef safety consortium
- 17 K-State scientists part of \$25 million project
- Top-ranked programs
- Architecture has 3 programs in top 10 nationally
- Engineering ranked in top 40 (undergraduate, public)
- Atomic, molecular and optical physics graduate program ranked 13th in nation
