
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 6 by Senate Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 6 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Current law authorizes a law enforcement officer to reasonably search a person arrested and the area within the person's immediate presence for discovering the fruits, instrumentalities, or evidence of a crime. SB 6 would change "evidence of a crime" to "evidence of the crime."

The League of Kansas Municipalities states SB 6 would have no fiscal effect on cities. There would be no fiscal effect to the state budget.
