**SB 505 - vehicle registration renewal notification**

Chairman Hayzlett opened hearings on **SB 505**. Sheila Walker said as a courtesy to vehicle owners, the Division of Vehicles currently mails registration renewal notices approximately 45 days in advance of an applicant's expiration date. **SB 505**, as introduced, would require the Division to annually provide this renewal notification. It also includes a statement that failure of the Division to send such notice, or the failure of registrants to receive the notice, is not cause or excuse to fail to pay the registration fees.
