

2012 Kansas Statutes

65-1,253. Same; transfer of powers, duties and functions; Kansas health policy authority abolished.

(a) The Kansas health policy authority created by K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 75-7401, and amendments thereto, is hereby abolished.

(b) Except as otherwise provided by K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 65-1,252 through 65-1,258, and amendments thereto, all powers, duties, and functions of the Kansas health policy authority under K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 75-7401 et seq., and amendments thereto, or any other statute, are hereby transferred to and imposed upon the department of health and environment and its division of health care finance and the secretary and the director of health care finance.

(c) Except as otherwise provided by K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 65-1,252 through 65-1,258, and amendments thereto, all powers, duties, and functions of any state agency, department, board, commission or council, providing services and creating systems in order to comply with the provisions of the patient protection and affordable care act, Public Law 111-148, 124 Stat. 119 (2010), and the health care and education reconciliation act of 2010, Public Law 111-152, 124 Stat. 1029 (2010), are hereby transferred to and imposed upon the department of health and environment and its division of health care finance and the secretary and the director of health care finance or their designees.
