KEES History - Significant events

- 2009 KHPA awarded State Health Access Planning (SHAP) grant to implement modern eligibility system for means tested medical benefit programs
- Grant used to fund "K-MED" project. Grant discontinued 2011.
- April 2011 CMS Announces 90/10 federal funding for Medicaid eligibility system implementation
- July 1, 2011, the KHPA, the state's Medicaid agency transitioned into the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) as the Division of Health Care Finance
- allocation requirements announced-allows Human Services programs to benefit from enhanced funding. August 10, 2011 - OMB Circular A-87 exception to cost



KEES History - Significant Events

- August 29, 2011 KDHE-DHCF executed a contract with Accenture, LLP. to implement K-MED
- Social and Rehabilitative Services Avenues Project (now contract with Accenture to include the Kansas Department of August 30, 2011 - KDHE-DHCF expanded the scope of the Department for Children and Families)
- August 30, 2011 State of Kansas re-named the combined K-System (KEES) MED and Avenues project the Kansas Eligibility Enforcement
- July 27, 2012 KEES Phase 1 Implemented Self Service portal for Medicaid Applications
- Presumptive Eligibility Portal for Qualified Entities

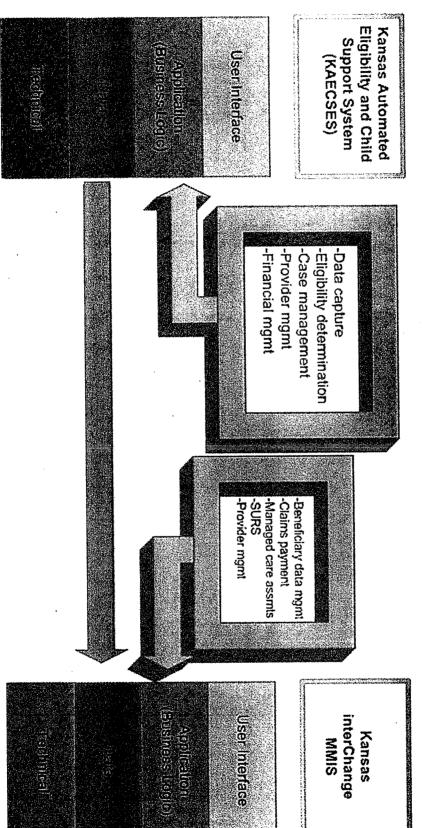

KEES - Phase II Vision

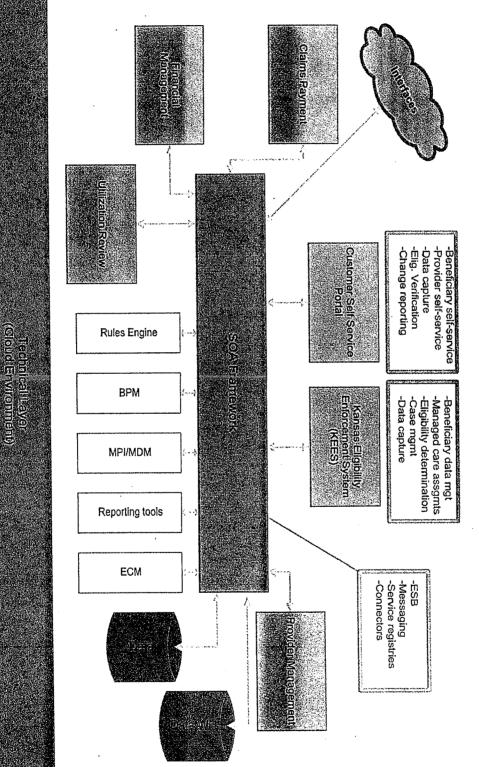
Current KS Medicaid Architecture

To Be KS Medicaid Architecture





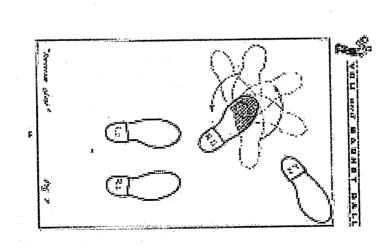

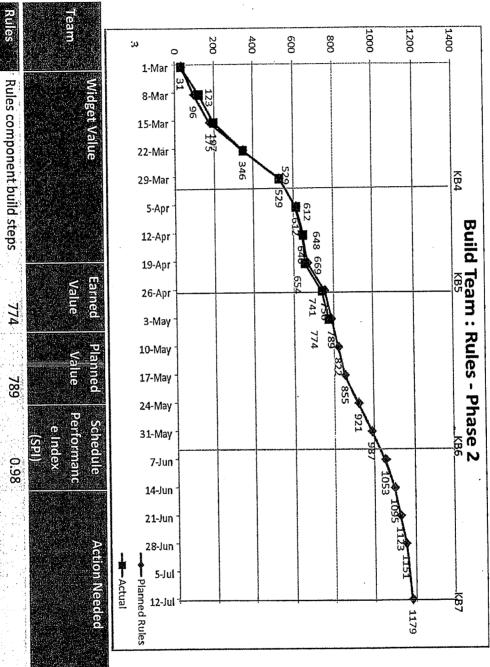

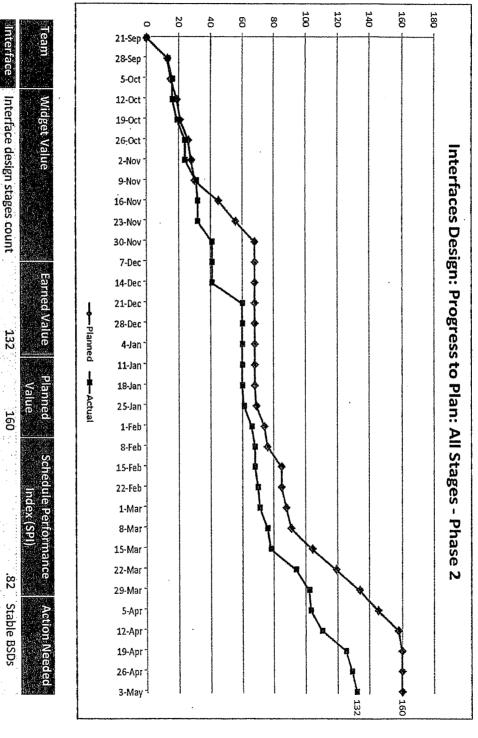


KEES Rules Build Status





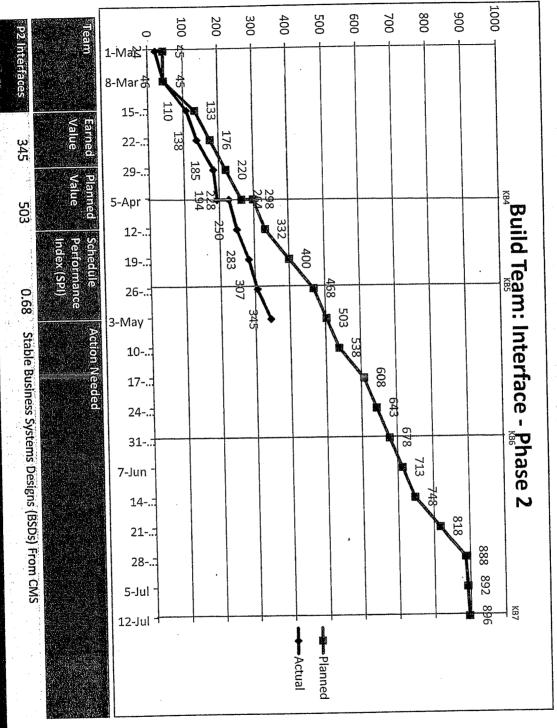
KEES Interface Design Status

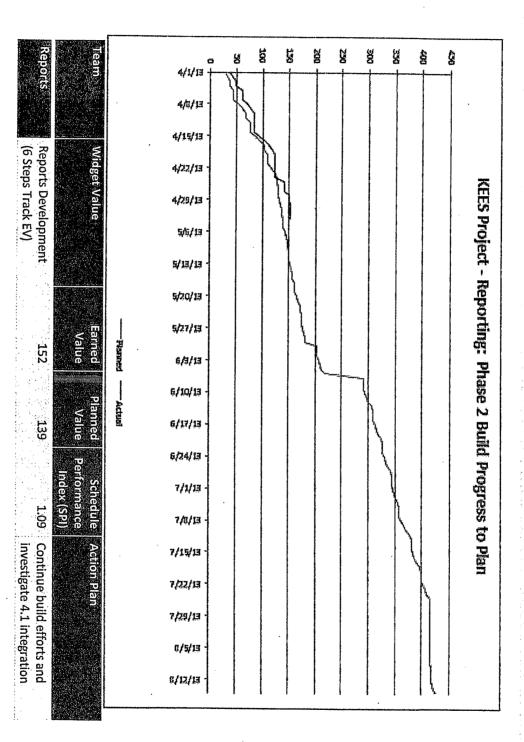


KEES Interface Build Status



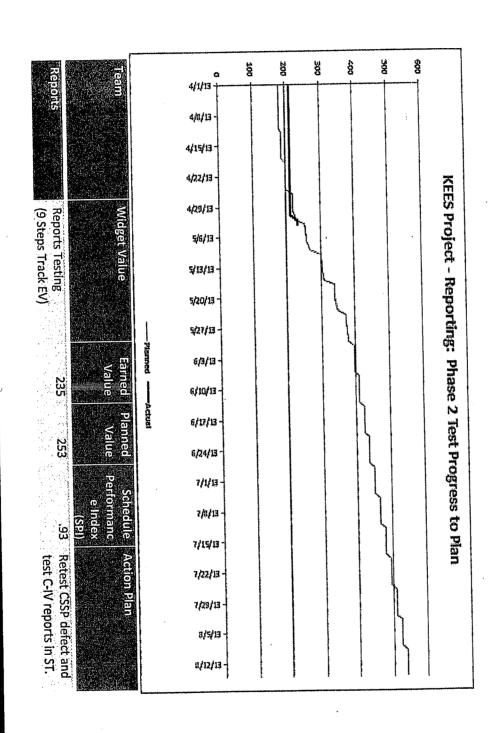


KEES Reports Build Status



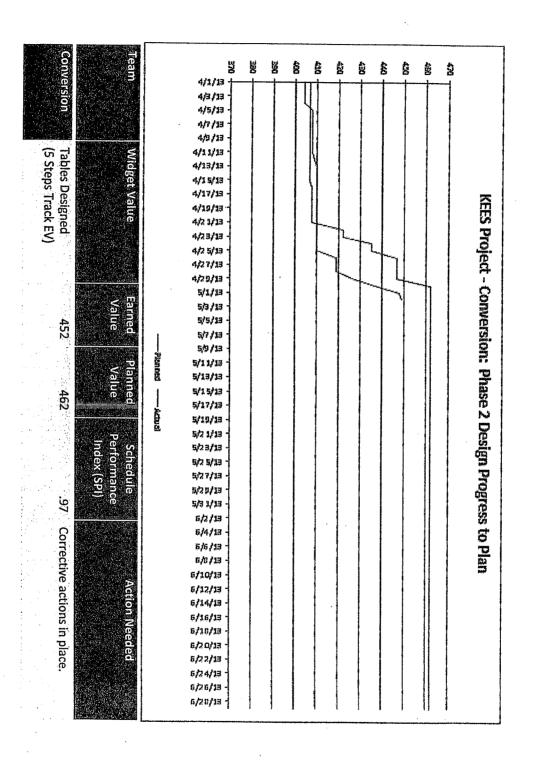


KEES Reports Test Status



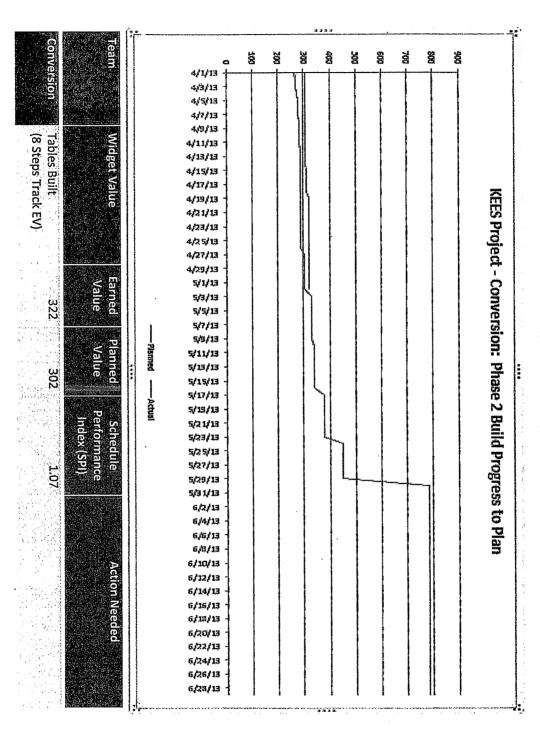


ANSAS KEES Conversion Design Status



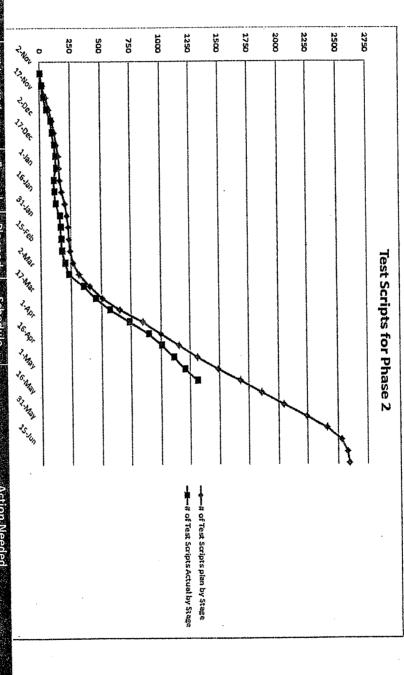


KEES Conversion Build Status





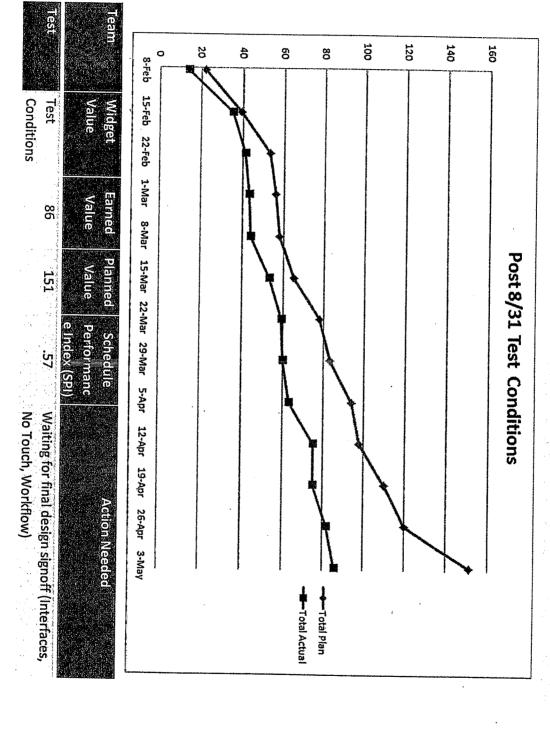

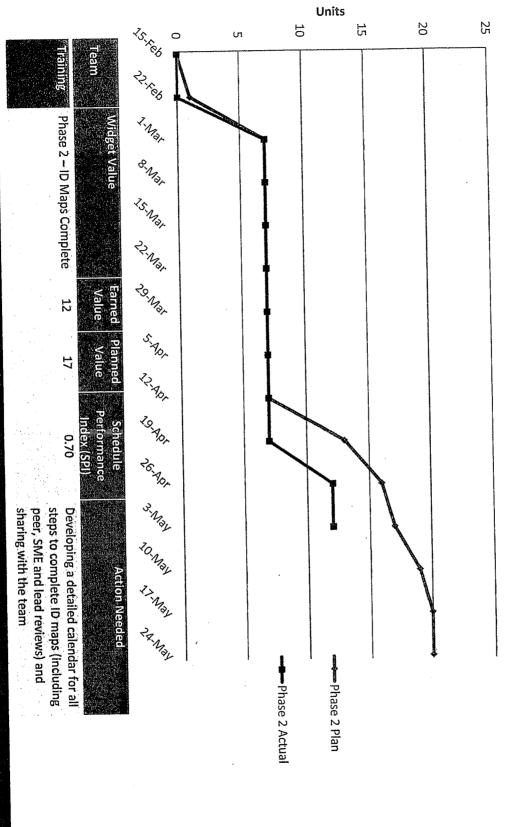

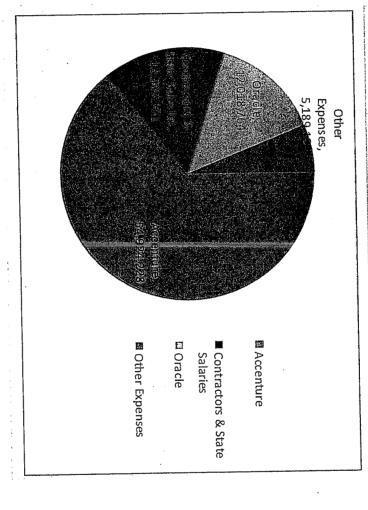
