1 AN ACT concerning the adjutant general; relating to the funding for  
 2 disasters; creating the disaster reimbursement fund, and Kansas  
 3 emergency management and homeland security fund.  
 4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*  
 5 Section 1. (a) There is hereby established in the state treasury the  
 6 disaster reimbursement fund. Moneys deposited in the disaster  
 7 reimbursement fund may be expended for the expenses of any disaster  
 8 which was issued a proclamation declaring a state of disaster emergency  
 9 pursuant to K.S.A. 48-924, and amendments thereto. Expenditures from  
 10 the disaster reimbursement fund shall be made upon warrants of the  
 11 director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by  
 12 the adjutant general or by a person or persons designated by the adjutant  
 13 general.

14 (b) On or before the 10<sup>th</sup> day of each month, the director of accounts  
 15 and reports shall transfer from the state general fund to the Kansas  
 16 emergency management and homeland security fund interest earnings  
 17 based on: (1) The average daily balance of moneys in the disaster  
 18 reimbursement fund for the preceding month; and (2) the net earnings rate  
 19 of the pooled money investment portfolio for the preceding month.

20 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
 21 publication in the statute book.

(b) There is hereby established in the state treasury the Kansas emergency management and homeland security fund. Moneys deposited in the Kansas emergency management and homeland security fund may be expended for operating expenditures of the adjutant general related to emergency management and homeland security, including, but not limited to, direct and indirect operating expenses. Expenditures from the Kansas emergency management and homeland security fund shall be made upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the adjutant general or by a person or persons designated by the adjutant general.  
 (c)
