SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2111 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2111 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2111 would amend existing law by prohibiting cities and counties from adopting ordinances, resolutions or regulations regarding the carrying of firearms. The bill would specify that it is unlawful to possess a firearm within any jail, juvenile correctional facility, juvenile detention facility, or prison. The ban on carrying firearms on the grounds of currently prohibited places would also be removed.

Enactment of HB 2111 would have no fiscal effect.
