Chairperson Kathe Lloyd called the meeting to order for the purpose of touring the Topeka Day Reporting Center operated by Community Solutions, Inc. Members of the Legislative Coordinating Council and officials of the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City, Kansas were invited on the tour.

Shelley Ghio, Program Director, gave an informative explanation of the program and demonstrated the global positioning system utilized by the company (Attachment 1). A client also shared his experience with the program and the benefits he has derived from it.
