

MINUTES OF THE SENATE ELECTIONS AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT.

Chairperson Allen welcomed the members of the committee and introduced the staff and committee secretary. At the request of Senator Allen, committee members introduced themselves and indicated which district they serve.

Ron Thornburgh, Secretary of State, introduced by Chairperson Allen, briefed the committee on the 2000 Presidential Election issues and their impact on Kansas. Secretary Thornburgh informed the committee on how the election laws in the State of Kansas are structured. Secretary Thornburgh will appear before the committee next week to present his six-point plan to improve elections in Kansas (No written testimony). Secretary Thornburgh introduced Brad Bryant, Deputy Assistant Secretary of State. He made note to committee Mr. Bryant will present a briefing regarding the election administration, ballots, recounts, contests, voting equipment on January 11, 2001.
